#### ORDINANCE NO. 2018-48

### AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING PARKING MOTOR VEHICLES ON LAWNS

WHEREAS, the parking of motor vehicle on lawns causes unsightly and muddy condition to exist which distracts from the curb-appeal of the City.

MOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF MOUNT STERLING, MADISON COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

## SECTION I:

The Council of the Village of Mount Sterling here adopts the following:

## PARKING OF MOTOR VEHICLES ON LAWNS PROHIBITED.

- (a) No automobile, motorcycle or other motor vehicle shall be parked or remain on any nonlarking or non-driveway portion of the yard of any residential or multi-family zoned lot. All motorized schicles shall be parked/kept only on an improved hard surface such as concrete, gravel and or asphalt. Such surfaces shall encompass the entire vehicle or trailer. All vehicles or trailers parked in parking treas or driveways shall bear the current registration or license plates as required by the Ohio Revised Code.
- (b) This section shall not apply during times of emergency due to acts of nature; or during time that a resident is in the process of moving in or out of the premises.
- (c) Whoever violates this section shall be guilty of a traffic violation of the minor degree and vehicle will be towed at owner's expense and would need to be removed within 48 hrs. from the tagging

### SECTION II:

This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by

That the Clerk of Council, pursuant to O.R.C §731.23, shall cause to be published in a manner required by law, this Ordinance.
