

Ordinance 2015-16

VILLAGE OF MOUNT STERLING BUDGET AND APPROPRIATIONS FOR 2016, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, A resolution to budget anticipated appropriations and anticipated revenues for the Village of Mount Sterling, State of Ohio, during the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2016 and ending December 31, 2016.

BE IT RESOLVED by Council of the Village of Mount Sterling, state of Ohio, that to provide for the current expenses, and other expenditures of the said Village of Mount Sterling during the fiscal year ending December 31, 2014, the following revenue sums are to be budgeted and the following appropriations are to be budgeted as follows:

This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the immediate passage of which is necessary for the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that is important to the immediate preservation of the public peace, the quiet enjoyment of property and family by the inhabitants of the Village of Mount Sterling and, wherefore, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and signature by the Mayor.
