NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF MOUNT STERLING, STATE OF OHIO

SECTION I.

Council of the Village of Mount Sterling authorizes Charles Neff, Mayor or his designee, to enter into contract with UCL, Inc., 2025 Stapleton Court, Cincinnati, Ohio 45240 for the repair and maintenance of the Village water tower in an amount not to exceed Four Hundred Seventy Five Thousand and 00/100 Dollars, (\$475,000.00). SECTION II.

This resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the Village of Mount Sterling. The emergency existing is extension of cell phone service to the Village of Mount Sterling and the surrounding area, thus providing better access to emergency and non-emergency services serving the citizens and business of the Village and community. This resolution shall be in full force and effective upon the passage and signing by the Mayor.
