SECTION I:

The Council of the Village of Mount Sterling hereby authorizes Lowell Anderson, Mayor, or his designee to enter into an Agreement with Jay-Car Construction Co., Inc. to provide drainage improvement at Mason Park. The Agreement shall not exceed Ten Thousand and 00/100 Dollars, (\$10,000.00). See Attached Proposal.

That the provisions of this resolution shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after the passage of this resolution and its approval by the Mayor and majority of Council.

SECTION III.

That the Clerk of Council, pursuant to O.R.C §731.23, shall cause to be published in a manner required by law this resolution.

This resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the Village of Mount Sterling and the enjoyment of Mason Park in a timely manner.
