A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE OF MOUNT STERLING TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION STATE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT AND I OR LOCAL TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM(S) AND TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS AS REQUIRED AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the State Capital Improvement Program and the Local Transportation Improvement Program both provide financial assistance to political subdivisions for capital improvements to public infrastructure, and;

WHEREAS, the Village of Mount Sterling is planning to make capital improvements to Clevenger Road, and;

WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvement herein above described is considered to be a priority need for the community and is a qualified project under the OPWC programs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF MOUNT STERLING, STATE OF OHIO

SECTION I:

Lowell Anderson, Mayor, or his designee is hereby authorized to apply to the OPWC for funds as described above.

SECTION II.

Lowell Anderson, Mayor, or his designee is authorized to enter into any agreements as may be necessary and appropriate for obtaining this financial assistance.

SECTION III.

That the provisions of this resolution shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after the passage of this resolution and its approval by the Mayor and majority of Council.

SECTION IV.

That the Clerk of Council, pursuant to O.R.C §731.23, shall cause to be published in a manner required by law this resolution.

SECTION V:

This resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the Village of Mount Sterling and timely improvement of Clevenger Road. This resolution shall be in full force and effective upon the passage and signing by the Mayor.
