# Resolution No. 2016-10

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING LOWELL ANDERSON, MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH J. R. MASON INC. FOR THE IMMEDIATE REPAIR OF THE WATER TREATMENT PLANT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

**WHEREAS,** Lowell Anderson, Mayor or his designee is requesting authority to enter into a contract with J. R. Mason Inc. for repair of the water treatment plant, and;

**WHEREAS**, the Council for the Village of Mount Sterling, after careful thought and consideration, believes that the repair of the water treatment plant is essential for the safety of the citizens and inhabitants of the Village of Mount Sterling.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF MOUNT STERLING, STATE OF OHIO

## **SECTION I.**

The Council for the Village of Mount Sterling authorizes Lowell Anderson, Mayor, or his designee, to enter into agreement with J. R. Mason Inc., for the purpose of repairing the water treatment plant. The contract shall not exceed Forty Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$40,000). See hereinafter the Proposal of J. R. Mason Inc.

#### SECTION II.

That the provisions of this resolution shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after the passage of this resolution and its approval by the Mayor and majority of Council.

## **SECTION III.**

That the Clerk of Council, Pursuant to O.R.C. 731.23, shall cause to be published in a manner required by law this resolution.

# **SECTION IV.**

This resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the Village of Mount Sterling. The emergency existing is the availability of clean drinking water for the Village citizens and inhabitants. This resolution shall be in full force and effective upon the passage and signing by the Mayor.
