SECTION I.

The Council of the Village of Mount Sterling authorizes Charles Neff, Mayor, or his designee to enter into the Contract for Services, attached hereto, pursuant to the terms and conditions contained herein.

SECTION III.

That the Clerk of Council, pursuant to O.R.C §731.23, shall cause to be published in a manner required by law this resolution.

SECTION IV.

This resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the Village of Mount Sterling. The emergency existing is the continued sound fiscal management of the Village's financial affairs, and policing of the roadway, streets, alleys and building within the Village. This resolution shall be in full force and effective upon the passage and signing by the Mayor.
