A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CHARLES NEFF, THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE TO ACCEPT THE BID AND TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH JAY-CAR CONSTRUCTION FOR THE PURPOSE OF BUILDING A WATER TREATMENT PLANT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Charles Neff, the Mayor, or his designee is requesting authority to enter into a contract with Jay-Car Construction, and;

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Mount Sterling, after careful thought and consideration, believes that the construction of the new water treatment plant is essential for the continued growth and prosperity of the Village of Mount Sterling.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF MOUNT STERLING, STATE OF OHIO

SECTION I:

The Council for the Village of Mount Sterling authorizes Charles Neff, Mayor, or his designee, to accept the bid and enter into a contract with Jay-Car Construction for the purpose of building a new water treatment plant. The contract shall not exceed Six Million Six Hundred Eighty-Seven Thousand Four Hundred Fifty-Eight and 00/100 Dollars, (\$6,687,458.00). See Attached Contract and Notice to Award.

That the Clerk of Council, pursuant to O.R.C §731.23, shall cause to be published in a manner required by law this resolution.
